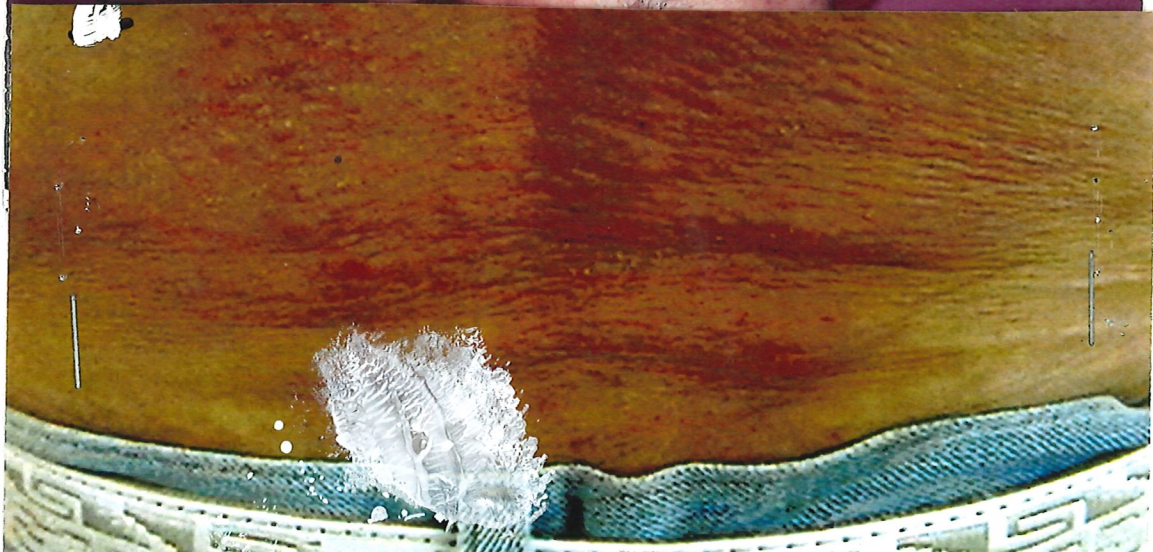

PICTURES OF LIFE-THREATENING HARM CAUSED BY EHS AND BY CHS.

The pictures show some of the health effects caused by my life-threatening Electrohypersensitivity EHS, and Chemical Hypersensitivity CHS.

Exposure to wireless/microwave radiation and chemicals and fumes commonly found inside schools and in other places caused me life-threatening rashes and loss of skin and swelling inside the skull so severe as to push an eye out of its socket!



ELECTROHYPERSENSITIVITY EHS, AND CHEMICAL HYPERSENSITIVITY, CHS.

I have been homebound for more than 13 years with painful, debilitating and life-threatening EHS and CHS, which are aggravated by exposure to the same wireless/microwave radiation and chemicals and fumes reaching children at school.

(Somehow similar to the life-threatening and deadly harm caused by even small amounts of peanuts to people suffering from peanut allergies).

Exposure to the radiation emitted by power lines, electric motors and transformers, cell phones and cell towers, Wi-Fi computers, Wi-Fi transmitters, radar etc., causes me among other things, swelling of vital organs, swelling of face, head and eyes; symptoms of heart attack and of stroke; and sleeping, vision, hearing, speech, memory, concentration and breathing problems. Exposure to chemicals and fumes causes me some of the same health effects. See Statement of Physical Disabilities, id.

I have a medical history of life-threatening swelling of heart; my rashes and loss of skin have been life-threatening; and the swelling inside my skull has been so severe as to push an eye out of its socket. I have been violently ill several times. At times, I struggle to breathe even with oxygen. I am sleep deprived and in pain all the time.

Everyday is a different torture. This is a horrible way to die.

My EHS and CHS have been recognized by federal and State agencies and by Courts as physical medical conditions and as disabilities under the Americans with Disabilities Act and under the Rehabilitation Act. See Statement of Physical Disabilities Appxs. 5,7,8,45-60, id. ***

"The World Health Organization (WHO) defines EHS as:

+++ (a) phenomenon where individuals experience health effects while using or being in the vicinity of devices emanating electric, magnetic, or electromagnetic fields (EMFs) EHS is real and sometimes a debilitating problem for the affected persons,"

Federal agencies that recognize EHS as a disability include the Social Security Administration, the U.S. Access Board, the U.S. Dept. of Education; The National Institute of Building Sciences, The National Institutes of Health, The National Council on Disabilities, and the Centers for Disease Control. State and local governments that recognize EHS include: Alabama, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Massachusetts, and Broward County Florida.

The International Code of Diseases diagnostic code for EHS includes: T66,W90, W90.1, W90.2, W90.8, and Z58.4

It is estimated that without knowing it, millions of children and millions of other defenseless and unsuspecting victims are suffering from EHS as detailed herein.

Appendix 1. Electromagnetic hypersensitivity (EHS): excerpts from a summary by Dr Erica Mallery-Blythe⁸⁰

EHS is characterized by an awareness of/adverse response to even extremely weak electromagnetic fields (far below current safety levels) of varying frequencies, intensities and waveforms. It has been demonstrated to be an "environmentally inducible bona-fide neurological syndrome". It is a primary physical issue, not a psychological one. Conscious perception can vary with age, gender and physiology. Effects can occur even in those not experiencing symptoms at a cellular level, and it is possible that everybody could potentially develop EHS as every cell in our body is dependent on electrical signals.

Common symptoms: Headaches, dizziness, sleep disturbance, sensory up-regulation, dermatological issues, palpitations, visual/auditory disturbances, membrane sensitivity, muscle twitching, hyperactivity/fatigue, memory/concentration disturbance and anxiety (psychiatric symptoms such as anxiety and depression are likely to be secondary to the physiological effects rather than a primary cause).

Exposure-induced: EHS is a cumulative, exposure-triggered condition, and exposures are rising rapidly. If EHS is unmanaged and there is general deterioration, there will be reaction to an increasingly broad range of frequencies at increasingly low intensities. The number of devices triggering symptoms will increase, symptomatic distances will decrease and irreversibility will become more likely.

The number of people with EHS symptoms who have not yet linked them to exposure is likely to be far higher than the estimated 4–10% of the population reported by several countries. Given the ubiquity of exposure in all environments, it can be difficult for people to notice the association. Extrapolated figures suggest that 50% of the population may be affected by 2017. With enough exposure, it is possible that EHS could manifest in all members of the population. Many children are affected but undiagnosed. They are more likely to develop EHS since their exposure is higher and their systems are developing.

Socioeconomic impact of EHS and human rights: EHS is already affecting a very large number of people, many of whom are unable to work due to their condition, resulting in lost revenue. An extra burden is placed on healthcare agency resources due to inappropriate diagnosis and management of common symptoms. In more severe cases, individuals are forced to live in extreme isolation, poverty and poor health, with some living in cars and tents, which can also prove threatening to health and life, especially in extreme temperatures. They cannot access basic, life-sustaining public amenities, such as grocery stores and healthcare facilities, which constitutes a clear breach of their human rights.

"I have been contacted on a daily basis by individuals with EHS, medical practitioners, school and parent groups, legal representatives, the media and political bodies looking for medical advice on EHS or the health effects of EMF in general. This is an increasingly demanding task and therefore I have founded a medical doctors organisation entitled PHIRE (Physicians' Health Initiative for Radiation and Environment) in order to increase the available support for those requesting it" (<http://phiremedical.org/>).

ORDER OF APPEALS COUNCIL

REMANDING CASE TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

The Administrative Law Judge issued a decision on April 4, 2017. The claimant has asked the Appeals Council to review this decision.

The Appeals Council grants the request for review under the substantial evidence provision of the Social Security Administration regulations (20 CFR 416.1470). Under the authority of 20 CFR 416.1477, the Appeals Council vacates the hearing decision and remands this case to an Administrative Law Judge for resolution of the following issue:

- The decision finds the claimant does not have a medically determinable impairment, in part, because his diagnosis of electro-sensitivity disorder is not recognized by the medical community. The claimant's doctor diagnosed this impairment and submitted evidence of signs, symptoms and laboratory testing (Exhibits 3F, 4F, 5F and 6F). In October 2014, the claimant's doctor noted he has been homebound for three years and has many symptoms from electric field exposure including systemic problems and skin reactions with blood pressure variations (Exhibit 3F, page 2). In May 2015, the claimant's doctor indicated the best treatment for the claimant's condition is to avoid all radiation, which causes him to be homebound. At the same time, the claimant was prescribed portable oxygen due to difficulties with breathing related to his impairment (Exhibits 4F and 5F). Laboratory testing from 2008 indicates abnormalities in auto immune functioning (Exhibit 6F, pages 63-66). The claimant submitted laboratory tests from 2013, which may also show additional abnormalities (Claimant Submitted Evidence pages 116-117). Further, consultative examiner Dona E. Cooper-Dockery, M.D. indicated that, while rare, the condition is recognized in the medical community (Exhibit 1F, page 8). Finally, the State agency consultants did not have the full record when determining there was insufficient evidence to find a medically determinable impairment. As such, further consideration of whether the claimant has signs, symptoms and laboratory testing to confirm a medically determinable impairment based on his electro-sensitivity disorder is needed.

Jesus M Mendoza (466-21-8796)

Upon remand the Administrative Law Judge will:

- Obtain evidence from a medical expert to determine whether claimant has a medically determinable impairment consistent with Social Security Ruling 96-4p and, if so, the nature and severity of and functional limitations resulting from the claimant's impairment (20 CFR 416.913a(b)(2)).

In compliance with the above, the Administrative Law Judge will offer the claimant an opportunity for a hearing, address the evidence which was submitted with the request for review, take any further action needed to complete the administrative record and issue a new decision.

The claimant's ability to perform work at all exertional levels has been compromised by nonexertional limitations. In his pre-hearing filings, the claimant alleged that he has a sensitivity to electro-magnetic fields. 3E/2. He asserted that he has life-threatening "Multiple Chemical Sensitivity" (MCS) and "Electrohyper-sensitivity" (CHS). 14E/1; 23E/1. He alleged that exposure to radiation emitted by power lines, electric transformers and motors, fluorescent lights, video display screens, cell phones, wireless computers, aircraft and vehicle radar, dirty electricity etc, causes various symptoms, including: swelling of vital organs, swelling of his face, head and eyes, symptoms of heart attack and of stroke, flu and allergy symptoms, inability to sleep, rashes and loss of skin, and breathing, speech, vision, memory and concentration problems. 14E/1; 2F. He asserted that exposure to chemicals and odors found inside buildings and vehicles have similar effects. 14E/1. He claimed that he has passed out from pain and the inability to breathe on several occasions. 23E/3. He asserted that he cannot drive. 14E/1. The claimant also asserted that he cannot walk farther than the next-door neighbors' house. 14E/1. He alleged that he cannot stay in his home for more than a few minutes, so he spends his days in his yard. 14E/1. He claimed that he wears protective gear on his "thoracic box" and head.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

After careful consideration of the entire record, the undersigned makes the following findings:

1. The claimant has not engaged in substantial gainful activity since October 2, 2014, the application date (20 CFR 416.971 et seq.).

The claimant worked after the application date but this work activity did not rise to the level of substantial gainful activity. The claimant's earnings records show \$957.00 earned in 2015. This is below substantial gainful activity levels. 21D.

2. The claimant has the following severe impairment: immunodeficiency (20 CFR 416.920(c)).

The above medically determinable impairments significantly limit the ability to perform basic work activities as required by SSR 85-28.



Sweden was on the forefront of cell phone technologies. Of the 40 electronic engineers working on developing cell phones, about half of them became EHS. id.

In the U.S. around 17 million suffer moderate symptoms of EHS; almost 5 million suffer severe symptoms of EHS; and 2.16 million are so disabled that they cannot work at all.
